Nomination & Election of Candidates

Assessor & Surveyor (4 Year Term)

A candidate for county assessor must be a registered appraiser or an appraiser trainee; have two years accounting experience or two years employment in an appraiser's office; and be certified to be eligible by the Department of Revenue. Candidates must submit the [Oregon Department of Revenue Assessor Eligibility Questionnaire](#) to the Department of Revenue in time for the Department of Revenue to determine eligibility and notify the County Clerk's office prior to the filing deadline. A candidate for the office of county surveyor must be a registered professional land surveyor within the State of Oregon.

NOMINATION

Nominated at the May 21, 2024 Primary Election

If a candidate does not receive a majority of the votes cast (50% +1), the two candidates who receive the highest number of votes are nominated to the General Election ballot.

ELECTION

Elected at the May 21, 2024 Primary Election

If a candidate receives the majority of the votes cast (50% + 1) at the primary election, the candidate is elected.

Elected at the November 5, 2024 General Election

If a candidate is not elected at the Primary Election, the nominees for the office will appear on the General Election ballot.

County Commissioner (4 Year Term)

The position of County Commissioner is a partisan office in Jackson County. The political party a candidate is affiliated with determines whether they appear on the Primary Election ballot and/or the General Election ballot.

NOMINATION

Major Party Candidates

Nominated at the May 21, 2024 Primary Election

Only candidates for Commissioner who are a member of a major political party (Democratic or Republican), will appear on the Primary Election ballot. Candidates, one from each party, receiving the highest number of votes will be nominated to the General Election ballot.

Minor Party or Nonaffiliated Candidates

Nominated through Convention of Minor Party, Individual Electors, or Assembly of Electors

Minor party and nonaffiliated candidates for Commissioner do not appear on the May Primary ballot. Minor party and nonaffiliated candidates file from June 5, 2024 – August 27, 2024 and appear on the General Election ballot.

ELECTION

Candidates Elected at the November 5, 2024 General Election

Nominees for the office of County Commissioner will appear on the General Election ballot.

Precinct Committeeperson (2 Year Term)

Candidates Elected at the May 21, 2024 Primary Election

Candidates for the office of Precinct Committeeperson only appear on the partisan ballot for the precinct in which they are a candidate and must receive at least 3 votes in order to be elected.

Assessor: must be a registered appraiser or an appraiser trainee; have two years accounting experience or two years employment in an appraiser's office; and be certified to be eligible by the Department of Revenue and submit the [Oregon Department of Revenue Assessor Eligibility Questionnaire](#) to the DOR in time for the DOR to determine eligibility and notify the County Clerk's office prior to the filing deadline.

Surveyor: must be a registered professional land surveyor within the State of Oregon.

Party Affiliation: Democratic or Republican

Party Affiliation Deadline: A candidate who files for a major party office must have been registered to vote as a member of that political party by **September 14, 2023**.

Filing Period: Begins **September 14, 2023** & ends **March 12, 2024** at 5:00pm

Filing Fee: \$50.00 made payable to the Jackson County Clerk
