Party Affiliation & Ballot Content

Since this is a primary election, the **Democratic** and **Republican** parties will use this election to nominate their candidates for the November 5, 2024 General Election. Please remember that your ballot will only contain the candidates and measures for which you are eligible to vote. The content of the ballot you receive is dependent upon your party affiliation and the districts in which you reside.

- If you are registered with a major political party (**Democratic or Republican**), you will receive your party's nominating ballot that will contain the candidates of your party along with any nonpartisan races and measures.
- If you are registered with a minor political party (**Constitution, Independent, Libertarian, No Labels, Pacific Green, Progressive, Working Families**) or have listed **Other** as your party selection, you will receive a nonpartisan ballot with only nonpartisan races and measures.
- If you are not registered with any political party (**Not a member of a party**), you will receive a nonpartisan ballot with only nonpartisan races and measures.

The last day to register to vote or change your political party affiliation for the May 21, 2024 Primary Election is **Tuesday, April 30, 2024**.
