The Jackson County District Attorney's Office announced this afternoon that Robert Paul Keegan was sentenced this morning on the three counts of conviction returned by the jury following his week-long trial last Monday.

Judge Timothy Barnack sentenced Keegan. On the charge of Manslaughter in the First Degree, Keegan was sentenced to serve 120 months in the Oregon Department of Corrections under Measure 11 to be followed by 5 years of post-prison supervision. Keegan was also sentenced to two consecutive 1-year sentences on the convictions for Unlawful Possession of a Firearm and Recklessly Endangering Another Person. All three counts of conviction were ordered to run consecutively as each count involved a separate victim.

All three counts of conviction stemmed from the incident in early morning hours on November 23, 2020 when Mr. Keegan caused the death of 19-year-old Aidan Ellison by a single gunshot through the chest.
