The Jackson County District Attorney's Office announced this afternoon that it has received the results of the Medford Police Department's investigation into the theft and misuse of controlled substances by a former Asante nurse that resulted in serious infections in numerous patients. The investigation started in December 2023 and involved the review of tens of thousands of documents, including medical records, and interviews with dozens of witnesses. Patrick Green, Chief Deputy District Attorney, is currently reviewing the results of the investigation.

Chief Deputy DA Green said today, "I would like to thank the Medford Police Department for its diligent and meticulous work on this complex and expansive investigation. I want to assure the community that I am working hard to review the results of the investigation expeditiously. If charges are filed, I will remain the lead prosecutor and assign two other senior prosecutors as co-counsel to assist with the prosecution. I share the community's concern with this case and will ensure it remains a top priority going forward."

Given the ongoing nature of this investigation and the possibility of future pending criminal charges, the Jackson County District Attorney's Office will not be releasing further facts regarding this investigation.
